RESOLVE, Increasing Retirement Benefit of Irving W. Small of Milbridge.

Irving W. Small; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Irving W. Small of Milbridge under the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be increased by the amount of \$25 monthly.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of this resolve is to correct, to some extent at least, an inequity which obviously exists. Mr. Small was retired on the basis of his average salary for his last 5 years of service rather than on the average of the best 5 years of service salarywise. Had it been possible to secure a benefit at the time he retired on the best 5 years rather than the last 5, he would have been receiving all these years practically double the amount of benefit which he has been getting, and the amount provided in this resolve is a compromise in effect to make some adjustment at least in this case. He is now 83 years of age.
