STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Orient for Aid to State Paupers.

Town of Orient; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,122.16 to be paid to the Town of Orient to reimburse said town for supplies furnished to Clarence Williams and family in 1960 and 1961.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Town of Orient furnished supplies to Clarence Williams, his wife and 3 children for the years 1960 and 1961. Through neglect, the bills were not sent to the State on time, therefore the State only reimbursed the town in the amount of \$774.42. The total amount of aid furnished was \$1,896.58.
