RESOLVE, Requiring State Highway Commission to Construct Overhead Directional Sign on Interstate Highway in Kittery Indicating "U. S. Route 1, Coastal Areas York to Portland."

State Highway Commission to construct overhead directional sign on Interstate Highway in Kittery. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission is authorized and directed to construct and maintain an overhead directional sign of appropriate dimensions on Interstate Highway Route 95 in Kittery, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile distant southerly of the Route 236 overpass, worded as follows: "Use Right Lane for U. S. Route 1, Coastal Areas York to Portland"; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sums necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
