IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Upper and Lower Range Ponds, Androscoggin and Cumberland Counties.

Fishing in Upper and Lower Range Ponds, Androscoggin and Cumberland Counties; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations opening Upper Range Pond, Poland, Androscoggin County, New Gloucester, Cumberland County; and Lower Range Pond, Poland, Androscoggin County, to fishing for all fish except salmon, trout and togue under the general laws from October 1 to October 30 of each year.
