RESOLVE, Regulating Open Water Fishing in Certain Waters in Cumberland County.

Fishing in certain waters in Cumberland County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to establish the following rules and regulations on the following waters: Lily Pond, New Gloucester, Cumberland County, open to fishing from the last Saturday in April to September 30 of each year and establishing a daily limit of 5 trout and removing the bag limit on pickerel, also the use of any type of motor, inboard or outboard, to be prohibited. The following lakes to be opened to fishing for all fish except salmon, trout and togue from October 1 to October 30 of each year: Crescent Lake, Casco, Raymond; Dumpling Pond, Casco; Panther Pond, Raymond; and Ingalls (Foster's) Pond, Bridgton.
