RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Certain Waters in Cumberland County.

Fishing in certain waters in Cumberland County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to establish the following rules and regulations on the following waters: Sabbath Day Lake, New Gloucester, Cumberland County, open to ice fishing from ice-in to March 31 under the general laws except there shall be a daily limit of 5 trout; Great Pond, Cape Elizabeth, Cumberland County, open to ice fishing under the general laws from ice-in to March 31.
