RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Sabbath Day Lake, Cumberland County.

Fishing in Sabbath Day Lake, Cumberland County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to make a rule and regulation to open Sabbath Day Lake in New Gloucester, in the County of Cumberland, to ice fishing from the time ice forms until March 31 and provide for a daily bag limit on trout not to exceed 5 fish.
