IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters of Aroostook County.

Fishing in certain waters in Aroostook County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the following waters in Aroostook County to ice fishing under the general laws from February 1st to March 31st of each year: Eagle Lake, Wallagrass, Eagle Lake, T16, R5, T16 R6; St. Froid Lake, Winterville, T14 R7; Long Lake, St. Agatha, T17 R3, T17 R4; First Musquacook Lake, T11 R11, T12 R11; Second Musquacook Lake, T11 R11; and Portage Lake, Portage Lake.
