RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Dow Pond, Piscataquis County.

Fishing in Dow Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Dow Pond, in the Town of Sebec, Piscataquis County, to fishing under the general law and establishing a daily bag limit of 5 fish and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait.
