#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Employment of Females in Certain Occupations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 30, § 33, amended. Section 33 of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 70 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 33. Application of sections 30-38. The provisions of sections Sections 30 to 38 shall not apply to any female working in an executive, administrative, professional or supervisory capacity, or to any female employed as personal office assistant to any person working in an executive, administrative, professional or supervisory capacity, and who receives remuneration on an annual salary basis of more than \$1,560 not less than \$3,640, or to any female employed in offices of common carriers which are subject to the Federal Railway Labor Act.'
