STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to By-lines for Editorials in Maine Newspapers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 137, § 55, additional. Chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 55 to read as follows:

'Newspaper Editorials.

Sec. 55. Newspaper editorials. Editorials in all daily newspapers and in all weekly newspapers in the State which are entered as 2nd-class matter with the United States Post Office Department and which are published regularly at least 52 times a year shall indicate by a by-line the person or persons who have written such editorials.'
