STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Purchase of Equipment and Vehicles by City of South
Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1933, c. 55, Art. 9, § 9, amended. The first sentence of section 9 of article 9 of chapter 55 of the private and special laws of 1933 is amended to read as follows:

‘Money may be borrowed, within the limits fixed by the Constitution and statutes of the State now or hereafter applying to said South Portland, by the issue and sale of bonds or notes pledged on the credit of the city, the proceeds to be used for the payment of indebtedness of the city contracted for the acquisition of land, the construction and equipment of buildings and other permanent public improvements, **the purchase of equipment and vehicles, either the first acquisition or replacement thereof, for use by the various departments of the city,** and the payment or refunding of bonds, notes and certificates of indebtedness previously issued.’
