COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 478, L.D. 681, Bill, "An Act  
to Provide for a Civil Service Commission for Town  
of Kittery."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first sentence  
of section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All appointments to the office of chief of police shall  
be made by the commission from an eligibility list made  
up after the examination of applicants. All applicants  
must have 5 years or more of satisfactory service in an  
organized police department.'
