STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Tax Collector of Town of Dedham in Collecting Lucerne-in-Maine Village Corporation Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1927, c. 43, § 11, amended. The last sentence of section 11 of chapter 43 of the private and special laws of 1927 is amended to read as follows:

'The collector of the Town of Dedham shall be entitled to receive the same percentage for the collection \$1,200 or 21/2% of taxes assessed under this section and the same fees in connection with the collection thereof which he receives for the collection of the town taxes;, whichever is the lesser which percentage and fees or sum shall be deducted from and paid out of the tax collected under this section.'
