STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Correcting Designation of Beneficiary of Mary M. Hanks Under Maine State Retirement System.

Mary M. Hanks; designation of beneficiaries corrected. Resolved: That the Maine State Retirement System is authorized to pay survivor benefits to the husband and children of the late Mary M. Hanks, in accordance with the existing statutes. The State shall be reimbursed for refund of contributions previously made within the 30 days following the effective date of this resolve. Benefit payments shall be paid from the funds of the Maine State Retirement Systems and shall begin on the first day of the month following the effective date of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to an oversight on the part of the deceased, Mary M. Hanks, the beneficiary at the time of death was a brother as designated many years previous and before marriage of the deceased.

The brother realizing this was not the desire of his sister after becoming a wife and mother left the check issued to be returned to the State of Maine.
