RESOLVE, Granting a Right of Way by the State to Catherine L. Howell of Cape Elizabeth.

Granting of right of way to Catherine L. Howell. Resolved: That the Chairman of the State Park Commission is authorized to grant to Catherine L. Howell, of Cape Elizabeth, her heirs and assigns, a right-of-way over an existing semicircular roadway at the easterly end of Two Lights State Park.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Catherine L. Howell is the owner of property to the east of Two Lights State Park. The only feasible access to her property requires her use of the above roadway. The road extends only a few feet into the park and will in no way interfere with full use of the park. If granted this right of way, Miss Howell will grant to the State a right-of-way diagonally from west to east across the park, which she acquired from Bertha V. Howell by deed dated August 12, 1936, recorded in Cumberland County Registry of Deeds, Book 1541, Page 73.
