SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 513, L. D.715, Bill, "An Act
Eliminating Certain Exemptions Under Sales Tax Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting
in place thereof the following new title:

'An Act Removing the Exemption of Coal and Oil Under the Sales Tax
Law.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 17, §10, sub-§IX, amended. Subsection IX of
section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read
as follows:

'IX. Wood. ~~Coal, oil, wood~~ Wood and all other fuels, except
gas, coal, oil and electricity, when bought for cooking and
heating in homes, hotels and apartment houses, and other
buildings designed both for human habitation and sleeping.'
