STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for a Study of Income Taxes by Legislative Research Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Study. The Legislative Research Committee shall study the types, scope, feasibility and expected revenue from income taxes in Maine, including both corporate and personal income taxes.
- Sec. 2. Advisors. The committee may employ such expert and professional advisors and such clerical personnel as its judgment may determine.
- Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Legislative Research Committee the sum of \$25,000 to carry out the purposes of this act. Any balance shall not lapse until June 30, 1965.
