STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Loans by York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Loans by York County. The county commissioners of York County may obtain loans of money for the use of York County, not to exceed \$50,000, and cause notes or obligations, with coupons for lawful interest, to be issued for payment thereof at such times as they deem expedient. Any loans of money in excess of the sum of \$10,000 shall be incurred only for the purpose of building, rebuilding, altering or otherwise improving county-owned real estate and personal property contained therein.
