**AN ACT Requiring Persons Seventy-five Years of Age to take Biennial  
Examination for Motor Vehicle Driver's License.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended.** The 7th sentence of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 348 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'Any person upon reaching his 75th birthday shall be required to take an examination to qualify him to operate a motor vehicle and shall be required to take such examination ~~upon reaching his 80th birthday and annually every 2 years thereafter.~~
