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**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Special Promotional Materials, Department of Economic Development.**

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**Appropriation for special promotional materials. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 to be expended by the Department of Economic Development for the publication and distribution of special promotional materials. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1965.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These general promotional materials would include special, one-use posters and decorations for non-recurring events such as national conventions held in Maine and for use by Maine organizations attending conventions elsewhere; "friendship gifts" for creation of good will toward Maine at such functions.
