RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Publications of Geological Maps of Maine.

Publication of geological maps of Maine; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 to be expended by the Department of Economic Development for compilation and publication of a full-color geological map of areas which have been fully geologically mapped within the State of Maine. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1965.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The geological survey places highest priority upon the compilation and publication of a full-color geological map covering the areas which have been fully mapped, geologically, within the State of Maine. This would make available all the findings of the survey, plus the U. S. Geological Survey, in one publication. Providing this basic information is perhaps the most important part of any public geological survey, since mining companies require it as a basis for exploration.
