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**AN ACT Prohibiting Cigarette Vending Machines.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 137, § 16-A, additional.** Chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 16-A, to read as follows :

**‘Cigarette Vending Machines.**

**Sec. 16-A. Cigarette vending machines prohibited.** It is unlawful to manufacture, own, store, keep, possess, sell, rent, lease, lend or give away, transport, or expose for sale or lease, or to offer to sell, rent, lease, lend or give away, or to permit the operation of, or for any person to permit to be placed, maintained, used or kept in any room, space or building owned, leased or occupied by him or under his management or control, any vending machine or receptacle in which cigarettes are held for sale.

Any person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.’
