STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Provide Funds for Matching Funds for Training in Machine Design at the Maine Vocational Technical Institute.

Funds provided for training in machine design. Resolved: That there is appropriated to the State Department of Education from the General Fund the sum of \$171,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$34,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 for additional classes at the Maine Vocational Technical Institute in South Portland to match federal funds under the National Defense Education Act, Title VIII, to establish a machine design course. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is to appropriate funds for a machine design course at Maine Vocational Technical Institute. The total cost is approximately \$311,000 for the biennium of which \$105,000 will come from federal funds. If Maine is to grow and produce greater numbers of desirable employees, such a course is necessary.
