STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Macwahoc Plantation for School Construction Aid.

Macwahoc Plantation; school construction aid for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to be paid to Macwahoc Plantation as a hardship grant for school construction aid. Said sum shall be expended on school construction in Macwahoc Plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Macwahoc Plantation, in building a needed addition to their school, has been unable to complete its building and pay the additional amount needed over and above the \$16,000 they were able to raise and borrow. They have exhausted their borrowing capacity; they have committed themselves to raising additional money to operate the larger building. They owe approximately \$2,500 on what they have completed and would like to finish off their small basement room for a school lunch-activity room, as well as install hot water and complete the present building. Five thousand dollars would enable them to pay off their debts, over and above what they have borrowed for this, and complete the project.
