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**AN ACT Providing Annual Fee in Lieu of Tolls for Members of the Legislature  
Using the Augusta Memorial Bridge.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1947, c. 185, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 185 of the private and special laws of 1947 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, as follows:

‘The State Highway Commission upon application and payment of a fee of \$3 by members of the Legislature shall issue a specially designed sticker for one designated motor vehicle owned or controlled by such member which shall be in lieu of toll for passage of such vehicle over the Augusta Memorial Bridge for the calendar year in which it is issued. The color, shape, size and lettering of such sticker shall be determined by the State Highway Commission and, except for the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, shall bear the number of the seat assigned to such member.’
