**RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Nezinscot River, Androscoggin County.**

---

**Nezinscot River; ice fishing regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Nezinscot River, in the Town of Turner, Androscoggin County, to ice fishing from the time ice forms in the fall until March 31st under the general laws, from the Central Maine Power Company transmission line crossing said river approximately 500 yards below the junction with Martin Stream to the dam in Turner Village.
