RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Chain of Ponds, Franklin County.

Fishing in Chain of Ponds regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a minimum length limit of 12 inches on fish taken in Chain of Ponds, Chain of Ponds Township, T2, R6, Franklin County.
