RESOLVE, Closing Outlet of Big Jim Pond, Franklin County, to all Fishing.

Outlet of Big Jim Pond; closed to fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close the outlet of Big Jim Pond, T. I, R. 4, Franklin County, to all fishing from a log boom attached to red posts on each shore located 200 feet distant above the dam on the outlet to Big Jim Pond to a point 200 feet distant below said dam marked by red posts. The purpose of this resolve is to attempt to prevent the infiltration of Big Jim Pond by yellow perch.
