IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Little Jim Pond, Franklin County.

Little Jim Pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting fishing in Little Jim Pond in T. I, R. 5, and T. 4, R. 5, Franklin County, for a period of one season, with hooks with only one point, by fly casting, trolling, flies and trolling and fishing with bait. Live fish is prohibited for bait. Daily bag limit of 5 fish or 7½ pounds. After this one season the pond shall be regulated according to the present law.
