STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Apportionment of Taxes Between Town of Dedham and Lucerne-In-Maine Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1927, c. 43, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 43 of the private and special laws of 1927, as amended by chapter 57 of the private and special laws of 1947, is further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 5. Apportionment of taxes between town and corporation. The Town of Dedham shall annually pay over to the treasurer of said village corporation out of the taxes collected from the inhabitants and estates within said corporation's territory a sum equal to $\pm 5\%$ 25% of all the town taxes, exclusive of the state and county tax, collected from said inhabitants and estates.'
