AN ACT Relating to Election and Term of Board of Assessors of City of Bath.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1947, c. 82, Chapter V, § 501, amended. The 1st sentence of section 501 of Chapter V of chapter 82 of the private and special laws of 1947, as amended by section 7 of chapter 177 of the private and special laws of 1951, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘There shall be 3 assessors of taxes, one to be elected each year on the first Monday in March by a majority vote of the 9 members of the city council, for a term of 3 years and until his or her successor is elected and qualified.’
