IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Pension for Jennie A. George of Orrington.

Jennie A. George; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$125 per month is granted to Jennie A. George, of Orrington, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1963 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Jennie George is a retired teacher, age 101 years. She has no living relatives. She requires more care than minimum boarding care provides, yet she is not eligible for nursing care.
