AN ACT Regulating Taking of Smelts in Town of Surry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1959, c. 154, Chapter B, § 2-A, additional. Chapter B of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1959 is amended by adding a new section 2-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Taking of smelts in Town of Surry. It is unlawful to take or to fish for smelts in any of the tidal waters in the Town of Surry, Hancock County, except by hook and line.'
