# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Increasing Funeral Allowance in Public Assistance Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 25, § 291, amended. Section 291 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 458 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 291. Funeral expenses. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$150 \$225 shall be paid by the State if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same, and if the total funeral expenses do not exceed \$400.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 25, § 315, amended. Section 315 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 273 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 315. Funeral expenses of persons aided. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$150 \$225 shall be paid by the State if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same, and if the total funeral expenses do not exceed \$400.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 25, § 319-N, amended. Section 319-N of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 30 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended by section 2 of chapter 273 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 319-N. Funeral expenses of person assisted. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding  $\frac{\$150}{$225}$  shall be paid by the State, if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same, and if the total funeral expenses do not exceed \$400.'
