SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 266, L.D. 780, Bill, "An Act Proposing a Study of Cost and Efficiency of Municipal and County Government."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Study of cost and efficiency of municipal and county government. The Commission on Intergovernmental Relations shall study the functions of county and municipal government, the efficiency with which such functions are performed, and their cost. It may consider and explore any problems affecting the cost and efficiency of county and municipal government.

The commission shall employ a research accountant for the purpose who shall work under the direction of the commission and its executive secretary.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$8,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
