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### **RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Operation of Advisory Committee on Education.**

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**Advisory Committee on Education; appropriation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$4,408 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$4,408 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 for secretarial and other expenses of the Advisory Committee on Education. ### STATEMENT OF FACTS

An Advisory Committee on Education was created by Resolves, 1957, chapter 160, and the private and special laws of 1959, chapter 161, provided \$2,000 for expenses of the committee. The 100th Legislature, through resolves, chapter 112, appropriated funds to provide funds for a part-time executive secretary, office space and traveling expense. This resolve is for the purpose of continuing the services of a secretary and traveling expense.
