RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Operation of Advisory Committee on Education.

Advisory Committee on Education; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$4,408 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$4,408 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 for secretarial and other expenses of the Advisory Committee on Education. STATEMENT OF FACTS

An Advisory Committee on Education was created by Resolves, 1957, chapter 160, and the private and special laws of 1959, chapter 161, provided \$2,000 for expenses of the committee. The 100th Legislature, through resolves, chapter 112, appropriated funds to provide funds for a part-time executive secretary, office space and traveling expense. This resolve is for the purpose of continuing the services of a secretary and traveling expense.
