COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 275, L. D. 789, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Percentage by Weight of Alcohol of Blood
of Operators of Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first 4 lines
and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 22, §150, amended. The 4th, 5th and 6th
sentences of section 150 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes are
amended to read as follows:

'Evidence that there was, at that time, ~~7/100%~~ 5/100% or less,
by weight of alcohol in his blood, is prima facie evidence that
the defendant was not under the influence of intoxicating liquor
within the meaning of this section. Evidence that there was, at
that time, from ~~7/100%~~ 5/100% to ~~15/100%~~ "
