## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Percentage by Weight of Alcohol of Blood of Operators of Motor Vehicles.

R. S., c. 22, § 150, amended. The 5th and 6th sentences of section 150 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

Evidence that there was, at that time, from 7/100% to  $\frac{15/100\%}{10/100\%}$ , by weight of alcohol in his blood, is relevant evidence but it is not to be given prima facie effect in indicating whether or not the defendant was under the influence of intoxicating liquor within the meaning of this section. Evidence that there was, at the time,  $\frac{15/100\%}{10/100\%}$  10/100% or more, by weight of alcohol in his blood, is prima facie evidence that the defendant was under the influence of intoxicating liquor within the meaning of this section.'
