**AN ACT Relating to Amount of Property Held by Senior Citizens Association
Incorporated of Portland.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

May hold property to amount of \$2,000,000. The Senior Citizens Association Incorporated, of Portland, a charitable corporation organized and existing under the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 54, is hereby authorized to take by purchase, gift, devise, bequest or otherwise, real and personal property, and hold the same to an amount not exceeding \$2,000,000; and to control, manage, sell and dispose of the same.
