STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT to Correct the Name of Heron Lake Dam Company and Relating to Its Powers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1846, c. 389, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 389 of the private and special laws of 1846 is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Shepard Boody, William H. Smith, Ebenezer S. Coe, Walter Brown, and their associates and assigns are hereby created a body politic, by the name of the Lake Heron Lake Dam Company with all the powers and privileges of similar corporations, and is hereby further authorized and empowered in addition to the rights that it now possesses, to hold and store water for manufacturing and power purposes upon any or all of its dams and works, without prejudice however to log driving purposes.'
