IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Retirement Benefit for Lona A. Tower of Warren.

Lona A. Tower; retirement benefit. Resolved: That Lona A. Tower of Warren, now vice-principal of Thomaston High School, be permitted to count as credit toward retirement the period from December 17, 1948 to January 3, 1951, said dates covering the period during which she was teaching American children in dependent schools operated by the Armed Forces in Japan. Said outof-state teaching shall be counted when she has completed 20 years of teaching in the State of Maine. She shall pay into the State Retirement System a percentage of the sum she earned in such out-of-state teaching, equal to what she would have contributed to the system had she been teaching in Maine during the said period.
