**RESOLVE, Providing Funds to the Washington County Development Authority
for Development of Recreational Areas.**

Washington County Development Authority. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to be paid to the Washington County Development Authority for the development of a public landing on Cathance Lake and adjacent camping sites and recreational areas in the Town of Cooper, Washington County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The 100th Legislature provided funds for various recreational developments throughout Washington County in order to aid the failing economy of the area. These projects have been very successful and are proving an important factor in boosting its economy. The Cooper project is a lake development along the same lines and should materially benefit the eastern section of the county.
