RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold Thompson of Calais.

Harold Thompson; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,500 for damages to portions of the Harold Thompson Farm as a result of the reconstruction of State Highway #44 in Calais, during the years 1959 and 1960.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Thompson's farm property was severed by the new construction for which he was paid damages by the State. The cattle herd was to be provided adequate access to grazing pastures on the side of the road opposite the farm buildings. Adequate access was not and has not been so provided. The damages asked for herein are to compensate Mr. Thompson therefor and for all other losses for which he was not compensated.
