AN ACT Providing for Rental Fees to Convert Subdivisions of State with the State Police Teletypewriter System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Rental fees to convert the State Police teletypewriter system. The Department of State Police is authorized to pay all rental fees for necessary wire or circuit mileage required to convert teletypewriter communications stations of counties, cities and towns having organized law enforcement agencies, with the State Police teletypewriter system.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the State Police from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$7,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$7,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 and \$2,500 from the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purpose of this act.
