STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Publications of Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 143-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 143-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 143-A. Sale of other publications. In the case of all other publications, excepting publications of the laws in whatever form, pertaining to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game that the commissioner deems advisable for the more effective dissemination of factual information, information of public interest or information tending to promote better public relations, he is authorized to fix the price, if any, at which such publication may be sold and delivered.'
