RESOLVE, Regulating Bass Fishing in Jones Pond, Hancock County.

Bass fishing in Jones Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Jones Pond, West Gouldsboro, to bass fishing for the month of October each year.
