STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Vesting United States Game Management Agents With Powers of Fish and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 26, amended. The first paragraph of section 26 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'Sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, police officers, constables and, coastal wardens and U. S. game management agents, are vested with the powers of inland fish and game wardens, and shall receive for similar services the same fees as those of inland fish and game wardens. Fish and game wardens appointed under the provisions of section 27 24 shall hold no other state, county or town office from which they receive compensation.'
