## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Reporting System for Payment of Malt Liquor Excise Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, § 18, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 18 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 413 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

'They shall also furnish a monthly report on or before the 10th day of each calendar month in such form as may be prescribed by the commission and shall not ship or cause to be transported into this State any malt liquor until the commission has certified that the excise tax has been paid or that the Maine wholesale licensee, to whom shipment is to be made, has filed a bond to guarantee payment of the excise tax as provided in section 21.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 61, § 21, amended. The last 2 paragraphs of section 21 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 413 of the public laws of 1961, are repealed.
